This study seeks to gain a deeper understanding of how innovative technologies can positively impact language acquisition, improve language proficiency, and provide an engaging and interactive learning experience for students.

3.1 Aim of the research

The aim of this empirical research is to investigate the role of innovative technologies in the process of learning a foreign language. In order to improve language learning outcomes and experiences, the project intends to investigate how various innovative technologies, including mobile applications, platforms, online interactive tools, and other new technologies, can be successfully integrated into language teaching.

3.2 Participants of the research

A questionnaire was the only component of the research. The study focused on several groups of high school and college graduates between the ages of 16 and 29, 66,7% of them were females and 33,3% were males. Thirty students completed the questionnaire in total. The reason for choosing this age group is because they have a variety of experiences with innovative technologies, new technologies

and language learning with technologies. Most of the participants were English major students they are very experienced in learning languages with innovative technologies.

3.3 Procedure of the research

The questionnaire consists of 22 questions there are different varieties of questions, such as multiple-choice, short answers, checkboxes, and drop-down types. The questionnaire were completed in December 2022. In the questionnaire students could express their own opinions about innovative technologies. They expressed the advantages and disadvantages of artificial intelligence in learning a foreign language.

3.4 Findings of the research

In December 2022, the questionnaire were completed. The first question asks about the gender of the participants. Of the 30 participants, 66,7% were female and 33,3% were male. It is worth mentioning that this information does affect on the results of the research.

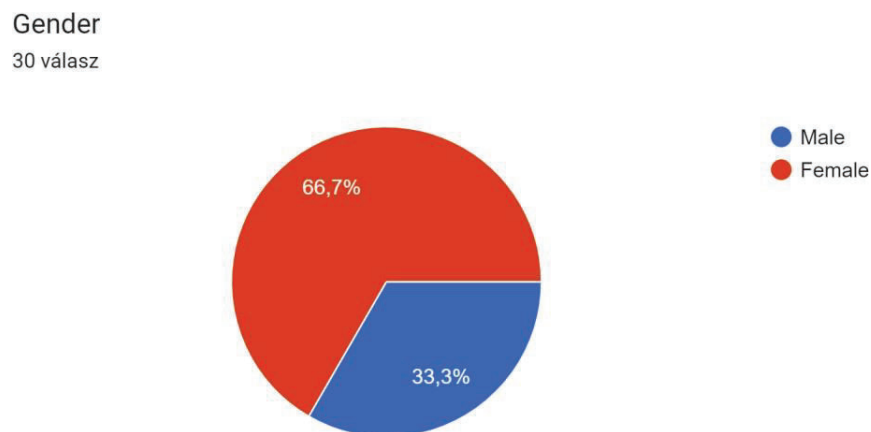


Figure 1. Gender

Age

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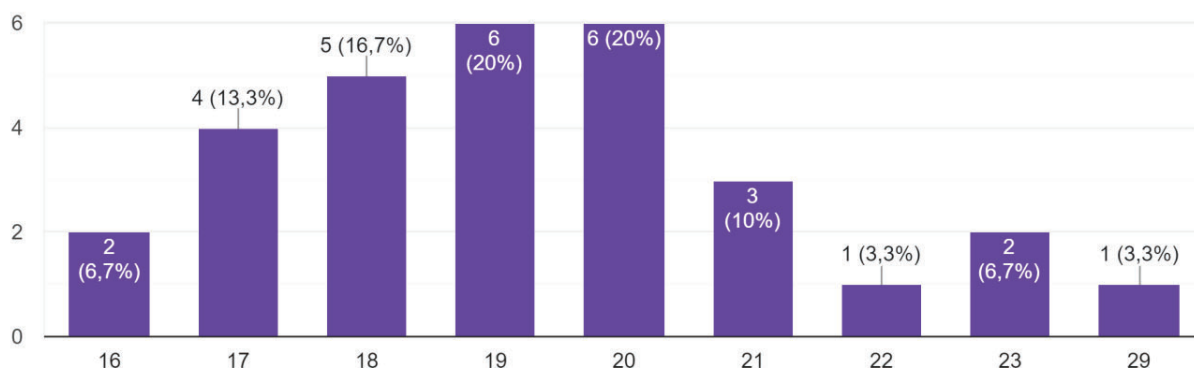


Figure 2. Age

Educational Background

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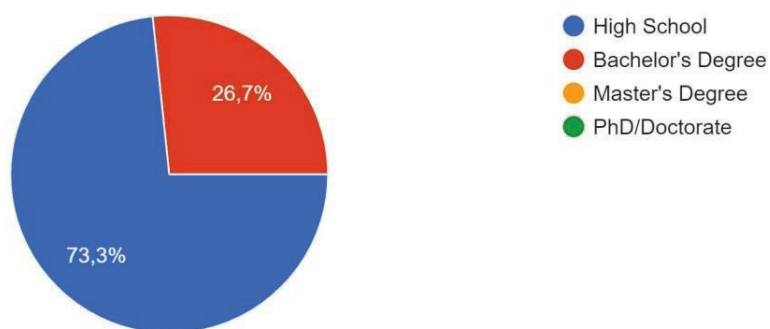


Figure 3. Educational Background

Have you used any innovative technologies to learn a foreign language?

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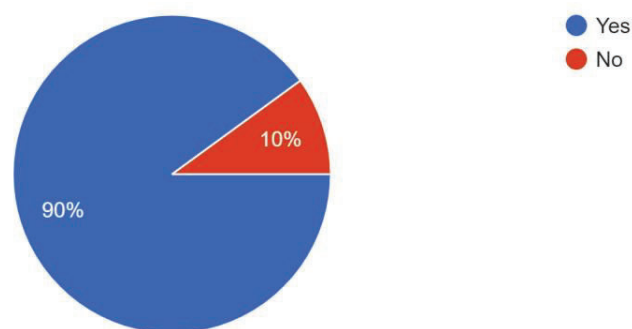


Figure 4. Have you used any innovative technologies to learn a foreign language?

This was a multiple choice question. It included four choices. Very effective, somewhat effective, somewhat ineffective, or not effective at all. The vast majority of the participants chose the somewhat effective answer 43,3%.

How effective do you think innovative technologies are in learning a foreign language compared to traditional teaching methods?

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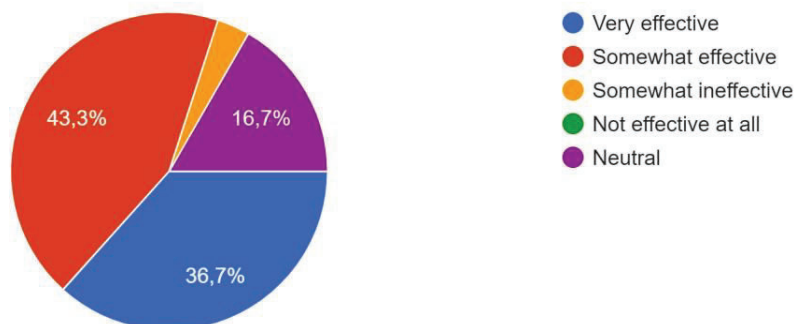


Figure 5. How effective do you think innovative technologies are in learning a foreign language compared to traditional teaching methods?

The majority of the students chose the slightly improved my language skills answer 56,7%.

In your experience, how has the use of innovative technologies affected your language learning outcomes?

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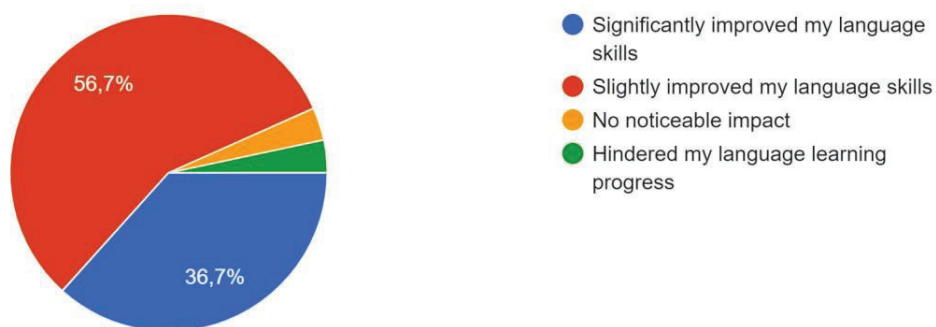


Figure 6. In your experience, how has the use of innovative technologies affected your language learning outcomes?

This question included six answers, the following answers were speaking, reading, writing, grammar and vocabulary acquisition, pronunciation and other. The majority of the participants chose listening skills 70%, it is also worth mentioning that speaking and reading skills were also chosen by many students both 63,3%.

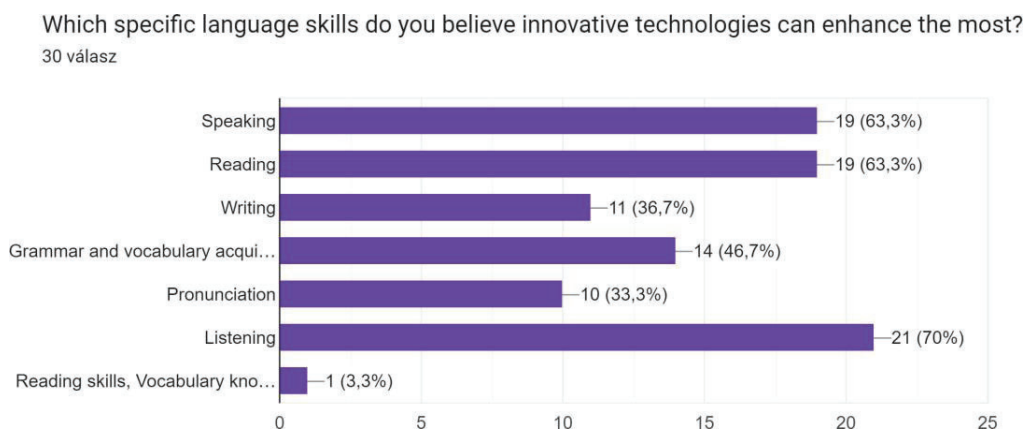


Figure 7. Which specific language skills do you believe innovative technologies can enhance the most?

Would you prefer using innovative technologies as a primary method for learning a foreign language in the future?

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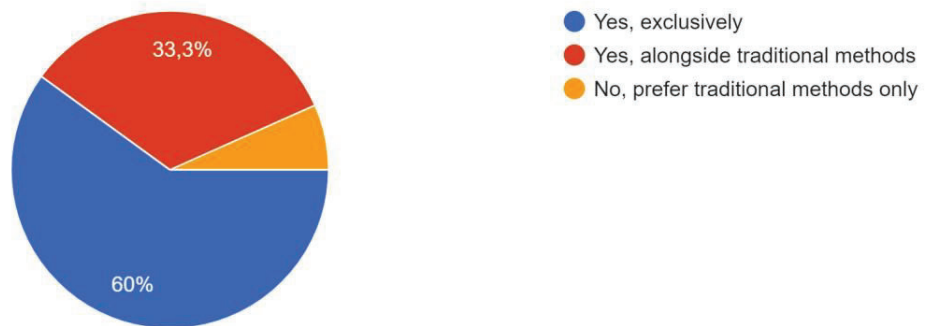


Figure 8. Would you prefer using innovative technologies as a primary method for learning a foreign language in the future?

Have you used mobile language learning applications (apps) for learning a foreign language?

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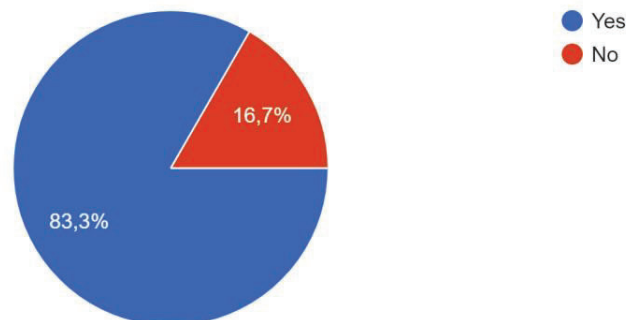


Figure 9. Have you used mobile language learning applications (apps) for learning a foreign language?

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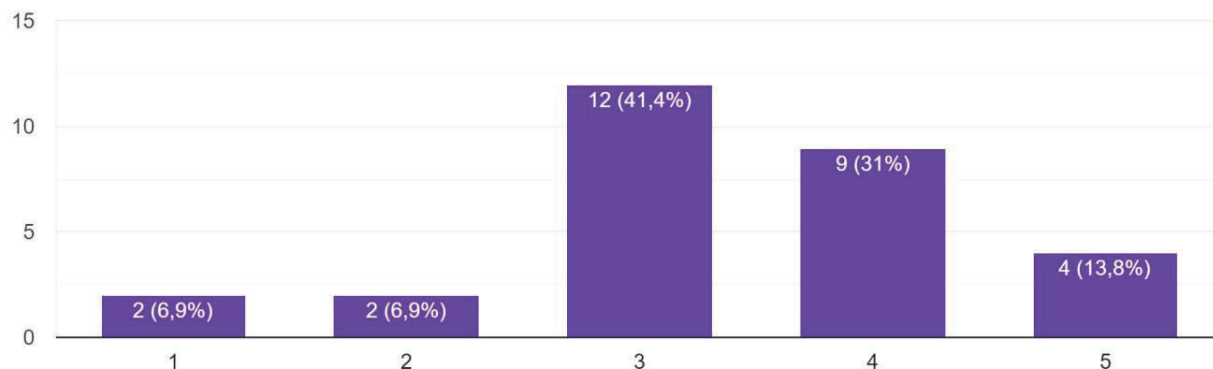


Figure 10. If yes, please rate the effectiveness of mobile language learning apps in enhancing your language learning experience on a scale of 1 to 5 (1 being not effective, 5 being highly effective).

Have you used intelligent tutoring systems for learning a foreign language?

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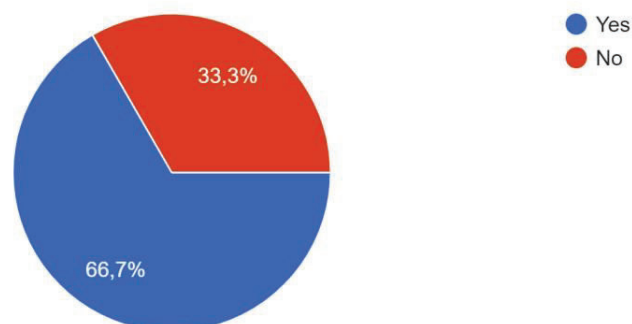


Figure 11. Have you used intelligent tutoring systems for learning a foreign language?

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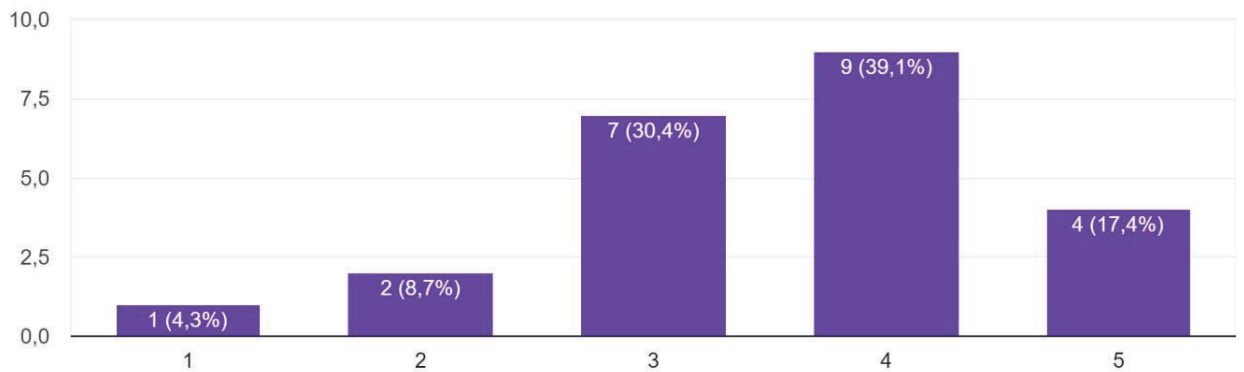


Figure 12. If yes, please rate the effectiveness of intelligent tutoring systems in enhancing your language learning experience on a scale of 1 to 5 (1 being not effective, 5 being highly effective).

What are the main advantages you perceive when using innovative technologies for learning a foreign language?

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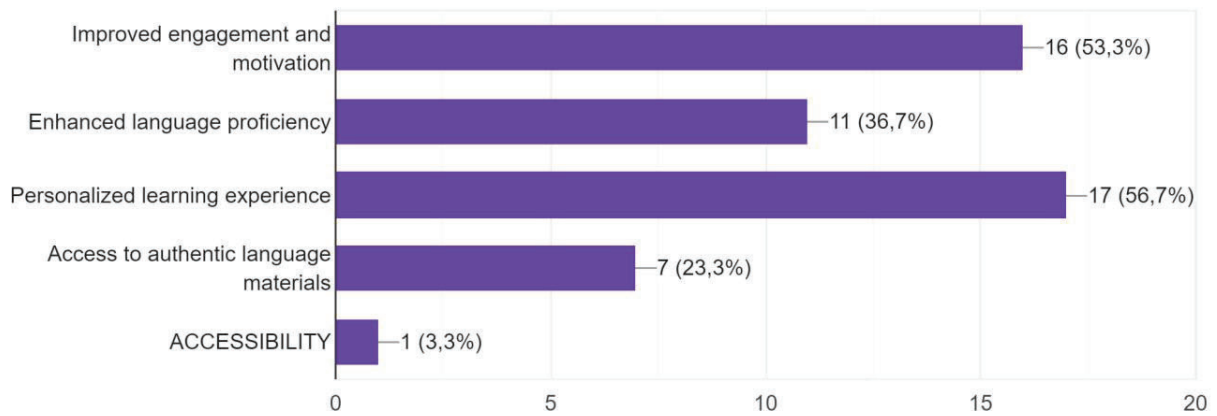


Figure 13. What are the main advantages you perceive when using innovative technologies for learning a foreign language?

How do innovative technologies contribute to your motivation to learn a foreign language?

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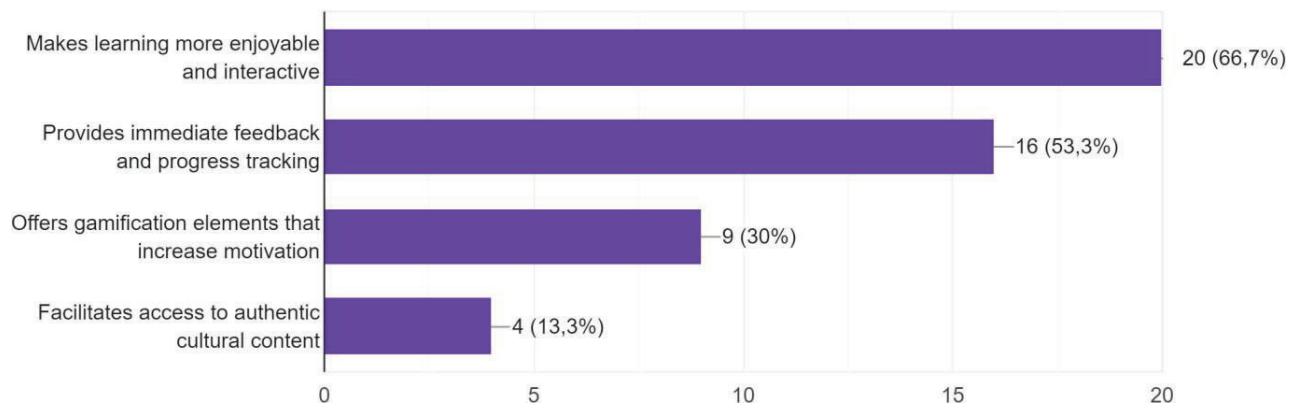


Figure 15. How do innovative technologies contribute to your motivation to learn a foreign language?

How do you stay motivated and engaged when using innovative technologies for language learning?

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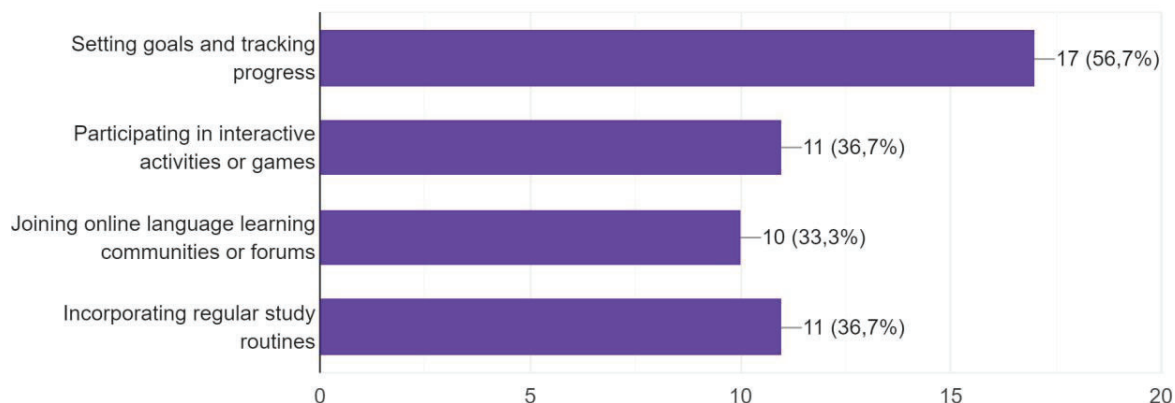


Figure 16. How do you stay motivated and engaged when using innovative technologies for language learning?

Do you believe that access to innovative technologies for language learning is readily available to all learners?

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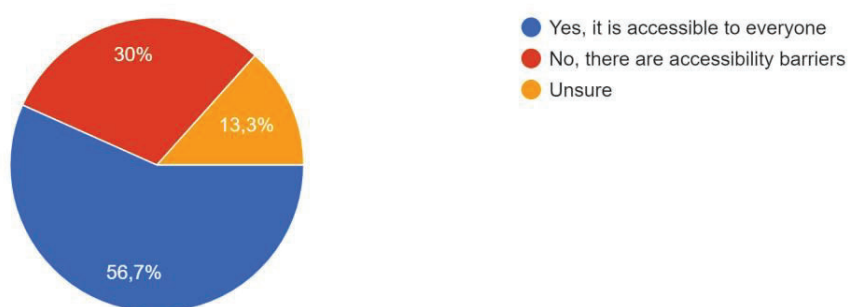


Figure 17. Do you believe that access to innovative technologies for language learning is readily available to all learners?

Overall, how would you rate the impact of innovative technologies on your foreign language learning experience?

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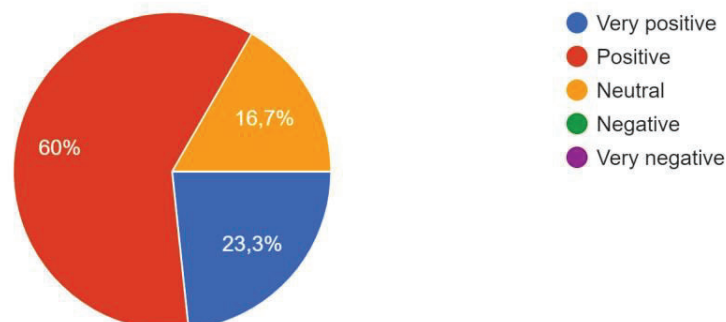


Figure 18. Overall, how would you rate the impact of innovative technologies on your foreign language learning experience?

How likely are you to continue using innovative technologies for language learning in the future?

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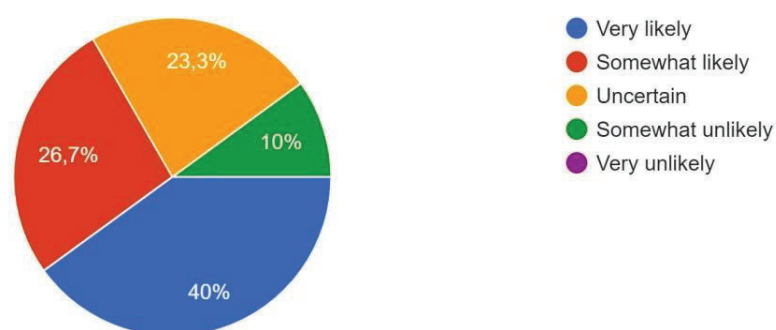


Figure 19. How likely are you to continue using innovative technologies for language learning in the future?

How effectively do you think educational institutions are integrating innovative technologies into foreign language learning curricula?

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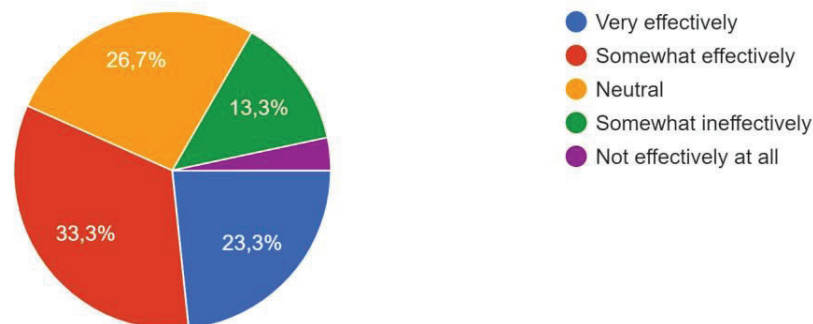


Figure 20. How effectively do you think educational institutions are integrating innovative technologies into foreign language learning curricula?

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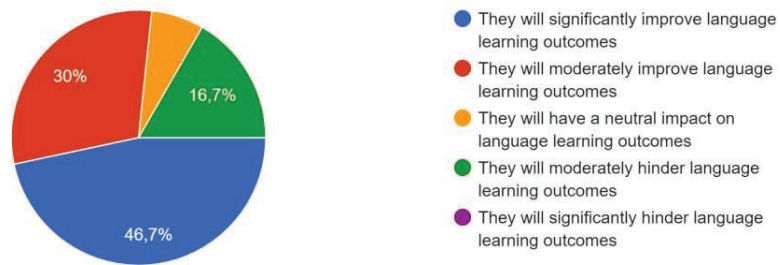


Figure 21. In your opinion, how do you foresee the long-term impact of innovative technologies on foreign language learning?
